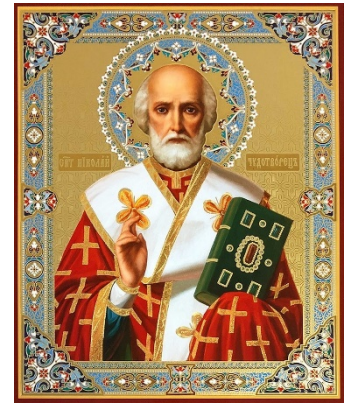

Pentecost

First Antiphon - Refrain: Through the prayers of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us!

The heavens are telling the glory of God; and the firmament proclaims His handiwork. (Ps. 18:1)

Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night declares knowledge. (Ps. 18:2)

Their proclamation has gone out into all the earth, and their words to the ends of the universe. (Ps. 18:4)

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Second Antiphon - Refrain: O Gracious Comforter, save us who sing to You: Alleluia!

The Lord answer you in the day of trouble; the Name of the God of Jacob protect you! (Ps. 19:1)

May He send you help from the sanctuary and give you support from Zion! (Ps. 19:2)

May He remember all your offerings, and fulfill all your plans! (Ps. 19:3)

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Only begotten Son...

Third Antiphon - Refrain, see Tropar

In Your strength the king rejoices, O Lord, and exults greatly in Your salvation. (Ps. 20:1)

You have given him his heart's desire, and have not withheld the request of his lips. (Ps. 20:2)

For You meet him with goodly blessings; You set a crown of fine gold upon his head. (Ps. 20:3)

Instead of O Come Let us Worship: Be exalted, O Lord, in Your strength! We will sing and praise Your power!

Tone 8 Tropar (Pentecost)

Blessed are You, O Christ our God, You have revealed the fishermen as most wise by sending down upon them the Holy Spirit, and through them You drew the world into Your net. O Lover of Man, glory to You!

Tone 8 Kondak (Pentecost)

When the Most High came down and confused the tongues, He divided the nations; but when He distributed the tongues of fire, He called all to unity. Therefore, with one voice we glorify the All-holy Spirit.

Instead of Holy God: As many as have been baptized into Christ, have put on Christ. Alleluia.

v. The Lord looked down from heaven, and saw all the sons of men. (Ps. 32:13)
